Parent/Guardian Codes of Conduct

We welcome you and your child's involvement within Rugby Gymnastics Club.

- You must ensure that all fees are paid by standing order on the 1st of the month and registration forms are completed before the first session. Insurance is paid by you directly to British Gymnastics and any competition entries should also be paid promptly.
- If an injury to a member is sustained outside of the gym session (e.g. school or home) then fee payments will still be required to keep the gymnast's space. If an injury occurs during a gymnastics session, or during a competition representing Rugby Gymnastics Club, and as a result they are unable to attend, we will hold their place until fit to return. However, we must be notified immediately and be contacted with a return date.
- Gymnasts should arrive at least 5 minutes prior to start of session to prepare for a prompt start time. This includes PlayGym and Pre-School classes. If gymnasts are persistently late then they may be unable to join in with their class. This is at the discretion of the Head Coach.
- Appropriate attire should be worn e.g. leotards/shorts/leggings/T-shirt. Rugby Gymnastics Club wear can be purchased and is usually in stock. Your Head Coach will advise if any extra items are required.
- Participant's hair must be tied back when long enough to do so and jewellery must NOT be worn.
- Please ensure that your children do not bring valuables to the gym, including mobile phones. Any valuables left at Rugby Gymnastics Club are left at your own risk.
- Parents/guardians should be aware of our Behaviour Policy and encourage their children to learn the rules and to participate within them.
- Gymnasts should be collected promptly at the end of a session. Gymnasts will not be permitted to leave the Gym Club without a parent/guardian to collect them.

- Parents/guardians should not enter the gym, beyond the gate, unless invited.
- You must endeavour to establish good communications with the club, coaches and officials. We will use our website and face-book to communicate news with you but do check Gym Club noticeboards.
- If you have any concerns with your child within our gym then please address these with us immediately.
- Photography and filming our classes is NOT PERMITTED. If you wish to photograph your child then please speak to a coach who can arrange this at the end of the session.
- Please set a positive example while on Rugby Gymnastics Club premises. We do not tolerate the use of inappropriate or aggressive language or gestures or any unsafe behaviour. We reserve the right to terminate Club membership if this is not adhered to.
- Smoking is NOT permitted on the premises, in the driveway or car park.
